


2020 Climate Change Survey Results



ArizonaForward
ESTABLISHED 1969

Arizona Forward engaged WestGroup Research to conduct a representative and statistically valid survey of Arizona residents. The purpose of the survey was to measure thoughts and perceptions of climate change in Arizona. The survey was conducted by telephone in July and August 2020. The total sample size of 400 has a margin of error of $\pm 5.0\%$ at the 95% confidence level.

82% of Arizonans are very or a little concerned regarding climate change.





56% report a decreased level of concern over impact of climate change in AZ over past year, 38% have an increased concern.

Three-quarters of Arizona residents willing to take action against Climate Change
