**Call for Entries for Arizona Forward's 39th Annual

Open for Statewide Submissions

The awards program is Arizona's most prestigious recognition related to statewide projects that impact quality of life. **The entry process is underway with an extended deadline of July 17, 2019 at 5:00 p.m.**
